The Executive Committee met at 4:00 PM to discuss agenda items. Dickie Calhoun, City Attorney, was present. At 4:23 PM, the council left the executive committee meeting to the regularly scheduled meeting.

Councilman Witherington introduced and summarized aloud Resolution 2016 -64 - Declaration of Surplus Property. Councilman Meeks motioned to approve Resolution 2016 - 64, seconded by Councilman Paramore, and being put to vote, was unanimously approved.

Councilman Witherington introduced and summarized aloud Resolution 2016 - 65 - Taffy Pippin Agreement. Councilman Paramore motioned to approve Resolution 2016 - 65, seconded by Councilman Meeks, and being put to vote was unanimously approved.
