Councilman Witherington introduced and summarized aloud Resolution 2015 - 36 - Reimbursement Resolution. Councilman Paramore motioned to approve Resolution 2015 - 36, seconded by Councilman Meeks, and being put to vote, was unanimously approved.

Councilman Witherington introduced and summarized aloud Ordinance 350 - Rezoning of Real Property. Councilman Paramore motioned to approve Ordinance 350, seconded by Councilman Meeks, and being put to vote was unanimously approved.
