The Executive Committee of the City Council of the City of Troy, Alabama, met at the hour of 4:00 PM., on May 12, 2015. Upon roll call the following were present: Council Members Charlie "Sarge" Dunn, Greg Meeks, Marcus Paramore, Dejerilyn King-Henderson, and John H. Witherington. Council Members absent: None. Shannon Bryan, Assistant City Clerk, presided as the Clerk of the Meeting.

The Executive Committee met at 4:00 PM to discuss agenda items. At 4:48, the council left the executive committee meeting to the regularly scheduled meeting.

The City Council of the City of Troy, Alabama, met at the hour of 5:00 PM., on May 12, 2015 in Regular Session. Upon roll call the following were present: Council Members, Charlie "Sarge" Dunn, Greg Meeks, Marcus Paramore, Dejerilyn King-Henderson, and John H. Witherington. Council Members absent: None. John H. Witherington presided as the Chairperson of the meeting. Shannon Bryan, Assistant City Clerk, presided as the Clerk of the Meeting.

The Executive Committee met at 4:00 PM on May 12, 2015 to discuss agenda items.

Councilman Witherington introduced the minutes from the April 28, 2015 meeting. Councilman Dunn motioned to approve the minutes as read, seconded by Councilman Meeks, and being put to vote were unanimously approved.

Councilman Witherington introduced and summarized aloud Ordinance 351 - Rezoning of Real Property and announced that this was the time and place to hear those in favor of or against Ordinance 351. No one spoke in favor of or against Ordinance 351.

Councilman Paramore motioned to approve Ordinance 351, seconded by Councilman Meeks, and being put to vote was unanimously approved.

The Executive committee recommended Mr. Larry Jarrel be reappointed to the Airport Committee. Councilman Meeks motioned to approve the reappointment, seconded by Councilman Paramore, and being put to vote was unanimously approved.

Councilman Witherington announced the term of Mr. Jason Thomas on the City Board of Education was set to expire. Councilman Witherington announced he had a letter recommending Mr. Jason Thomas be reappointed, and also a letter recommending Ms. Rhonda Pollard be appointed. Councilman Witherington asked for nominations to be made, hearing none, Councilman Witherington motioned to appoint Ms. Rhonda Pollard to the Troy City Board of Education, seconded by Councilman Meeks, and being put to vote, Councilmembers Dunn, Meeks, Paramore, and Witherington - yea. Councilwoman Henderson - Nay. Ms. Rhonda Pollard was approved by majority vote.
