Witherington presided as the Chairperson of the meeting. The Assistant City Clerk, Shannon Bryan, presided as the Clerk of the Meeting.

The Executive Committee met at 4:00 PM to discuss agenda items. At 4:25, Councilman Paramore motioned to enter into executive session to discuss the good name and character of an individual, seconded by Councilman Meeks, and being put to vote was unanimously approved. At 4:43 Councilman Dunn motioned to leave executive session, seconded by Councilman Paramore, and being put to vote was unanimously approved.
