Witherington presided as the Chairperson of the meeting. Shannon Bryan, Assistant City Clerk, presided as the Clerk of the Meeting.

The Executive Committee met at 4:00 PM to discuss agenda items. At 4:57, the council left the executive committee meeting to the regularly scheduled meeting.

Councilman Witherington introduced and summarized aloud Resolution 2014 - 104 - Budget Amendment - Public Works. Councilman Meeks motioned to approve Resolution 2014 - 104, seconded by Councilman Dunn, and being put to vote, was unanimously approved.

Councilman Witherington introduced and summarized aloud Resolution 2014 - 105 - Bid Award - Public Works Trucks. Councilman Paramore motioned to approve Resolution 2014 - 105, seconded by Councilwoman Henderson, and being put to vote, was unanimously approved.

Councilman Witherington announced Ordinance 348 - Rezoning Real Property, for the first reading.
