Upon roll call the following were present: Council Members Greg Meeks, Marcus Paramore, John H. Witherington and Dejerilyn King-Henderson. Council Members absent: Charlie "Sarge" Dunn. John H. Witherington presided as the Chairperson of the meeting. The City Clerk, Alton Starling, presided as the Clerk of the Meeting.

The Executive Committee met at 4:00 PM to discuss agenda items.

The City Council of the City of Troy, Alabama, met at the hour of 5:00 PM., on March 12, 2013 in Regular Session. Councilman Witherington introduced the application for a Taxicab License - The Designated Driver. Councilman Meeks motioned to approve the license, seconded by Councilwoman Henderson, and being put to vote was unanimously approved.
