NOTICE OF DECLARATION OF ABANDONMENT OF CEMETERY

Mullins Cemetery

Notice is hereby given of the declaration of abandonment of lands for cemetery purposes and of the intention to remove the human bodies interred therein. Mullins Cemetery is a small family cemetery with both marked and unmarked graves. The oldest known interment is Amelia Howard (1813-1880) and the most recent in Thomas K. Mullins (1809-1886).

The City of Troy with the approval of the descendants of the Mullins Family, seek to relocate the graves to Hephzibah Baptist Church Cemetery, 1.5 miles southwest of the Mullins Cemetery.

In accordance with Alabama Code Section 11-47-62 The City of Troy hereby gives notice that beginning on July 6, 2026, it will begin the process to remove for relocation the human remains within the marked and unmarked graves at the existing cemetery located at the 409 Mullins Place, Troy, Alabama. Said property is owned by The City of Troy and is situated in the Southwest quarter of Section 12, Township 9 North, Range 20 East, Pike County, Alabama. At any time after the expiration of two months from and after the first publication of the notice of declaration of abandonment and removal required to be published under the provisions of Section 11-47-62, the human remains then remaining in the cemetery or part thereof will be removed and subsequently reinterred within an existing cemetery by The City of Troy.
